RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract amendment with First Baptist Church of Pittsburg, California, a non-profit Corporation, effective October 1, 2019, to add 15 full-time Head Start slots to the East Leland location and increase the payment limit by \$48,905 to new payment limit of \$1,905,974.53 with no change to the term July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment will increase budgeted expenditures by \$48,905.00 to a new payment limit of \$1,905,974.53, funded 19% by Federal revenues (\$355,378) from Administration for Children and Families (CFDA No. 93.600) and funded 81% by State revenues (\$1,550,596.53) from California Department of Education.

The Contra Costa County Contract # for this grant is 38-906.
