Subject: Grant Award Amendment #28-701-7 from the U. S. Dept. of Health and Human Services, Runaway and Homeless Youth Transitional Living Program funding

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute Grant Award Amendment #28-701-7 (State #90CX7276-02-01) from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration for the Children and Families, Family and Youth Services Bureau, to amend grant Award #28-701-6, to increase the amount payable to County by \$52,000 to a new amount not to exceed \$252,000 for the period from September 30, 2019 through September 29, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment will allow County to receive an additional amount not to exceed \$52,000 from the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration for the operation of a transitional housing program for homeless young adults. No additional County match required.

BACKGROUND:

On November 5, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Grant Award #28-701-6 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration for the Children and Families (ACF), Family and Youth Services Bureau, for funding through the Transitional

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

Approval of Grant Award Amendment Agreement #28-701-7 will allow for additional funding to support housing, educational and vocational opportunities, and life skills to homeless young people, that will enable them to become self-sufficient, productive adults, through September 29, 2020.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, the transitional living program would be required to operate at reduced capacity, displacing youth back into homelessness.
