BACKGROUND:

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing an average of 35 congregate one day per week for senior citizens at the Oakley Senior Center.

On January 7, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #28-906 with City of Oakley to provide congregate meal services for County's Senior Nutrition Program, for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, which included a three-month automatic
