Subject: Amendment #74-475-94(2) with Mahmood Ketabchi, MFT

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract Amendment Agreement #74-475-94(2) with Mahmood Ketabchi, MFT, an individual, effective May 1, 2020, to amend Contract #74-475-94(1), to increase the payment limit by \$175,000, from \$86,000 to a new payment limit of \$261,000, with no change in the term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 50% by Federal Medi-Cal and 50% by State Mental Health Realignment. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

In July 2019, the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed Contract #74-475-94(1), with Mahmood Ketabchi, MFT for the provision of Medi-Cal specialty mental health services for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021.

At the time of negotiations, the payment limit was based on target levels of utilization.
