BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

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- 1. Section 21. <u>Fire Emergency Recall and Standby Differential</u>. Clarified that the standby with emergency recall duty differential applies to all classifications covered by the resolution except for the Fire Chief.
- 2. **Section 26**. No Fire Services Standby Duty with Emergency Recall Differential. Made non-substantive changes to the title of the differential that does not apply to the Fire Chief.
