RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-473-28 with SHC Services, Inc. (dba Supplemental Health Care), a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 to provide temporary medical staffing services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC), Contra Costa Health Centers and County’s Detention Facilities for the period from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On March 26, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-473-27 with SHC Services, Inc. (dba Supplemental Health Care), to provide temporary nurses, medical assistants and other ancillary staffing services at CCRMC, Contra Costa Health Centers and County’s Detention Facilities, for the period from April 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.
