Subject: APPROVE and AUTHORIZE Amendment No. 2 to the Contract with Battalion One Fire Protection, Inc., to extend On-Call Fire Sprinkler Services

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a contract amendment with Battalion One Fire Protection, Inc., to increase rates under the contract and extend the term from September 30, 2020 to September 30, 2021, to provide on-call fire sprinkler services to County facilities, with no change to the payment limit of \$2,800,000, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

100% General Fund.

BACKGROUND:

Public Works Facilities Services is responsible for maintaining, repairing and certifying fire sprinkler systems at various County facilities to assure County systems are in compliance. Battalion One Fire Protection, Inc., provides a full scope of fire sprinkler repair and certification services, including but not limited to inspections, fire sprinkler systems, fire alarm detection and repairs, 24-hour emergency service, UL Certifications, fire extinguishers and system monitoring.
