RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-577-18 with All Health Services, Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$850,000, to provide temporary medical staffing services at the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC), Contra Costa Health Centers and Detention Facilities for the period from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On July 23, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-577-17 with All Health Services, Corporation to provide temporary medical staffing services at CCRMC, Contra Costa Health Centers, and Detention Facilities, including Specialty Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioners and Medical Surgery Registered Nurses for the period from May 1, 2010 through June 30, 2020.
