This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing mobile clinic services, including comprehensive preventive health screening, primary health care services, immunizations, TB testing, sports physicals, and well-child examination to low-income and disadvantaged school children at Freedom High School, Heritage High School, La Paloma High School, Liberty High School, and Independence High School.

On September 13, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Interagency Agreement #28-885, (as amended by Contract Amendment Agreement

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

#28-885-1) with Liberty Union High School District for the provision of low-income and disadvantaged children to receive school-based mobile clinic services, for the period from July 1, 2016 through July 31, 2020.

Approval of Contract #28-885-2 will allow the Contractor to continue providing services through July 31, 2025.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, low-income and disadvantaged school children in the Liberty Union High School District will not receive preventive health screenings, well-child examinations, and primary health care services from County's mobile clinics.

CHILDREN'S IMPACT STATEMENT:

This program supports the following Board of Supervisors' community outcomes: "Children Ready for and Succeeding in School" and Communities that are Safe and Provide a High Quality of Life for Children and Families". Expected program outcomes include an increase in the number of healthy children within the District.
