Subject: Materials Testing and Inspection Contract with Construction Testing Services.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Construction Testing Services in the amount of \$850,000 for on-call materials testing and inspection services, for the period November 10, 2020 through November 10, 2023, with a one-year extension option, which may be extended to November 10, 2024, if elected by the Public Works Director.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Work performed under this on-call Contract is funded with various funds when there is an approved project and funding.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Woks Department is involved in various Facilities projects in the County that require materials testing and inspection services. After a solicitation process, this firm was selected as the third of five firms to provide materials testing inspection services on an "on-call" basis. This on-call contract will be in effect for three years with a one-year extension option. Government Code section 31000 authorizes the County to contract for services including the type of material testing and inspections services that Construction
