FISCAL IMPACT:

Work performed under this on-call Contract is funded with various funds when there is an approved project and funding.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Woks Department is involved in various Facilities projects in the County that require materials testing and inspection services. After a solicitation process, this firm was selected as the third of five firms to provide materials testing inspection services on an "on-call" basis. This on-call contract will be in effect for three years with a one-year extension option.
