FISCAL IMPACT:

This action will establish the revenue and expenditure budgets related to the CalFresh program in the Employment and Human Services Department as a result of \$6,394,115 in additional revenue.

BACKGROUND:

In FY 2019-2020, EHSD received additional \$6,394,115 in revenues. The additional revenue includes an increase in the final allocations, including COVID-19 emergency funding, and prior year revenue.

CalFresh is funded with 50% Federal revenue, 35% state revenue, and 15% County funds.
