Subject: Contract #26-718-6 with The Wright Institute

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-718-6 with The Wright Institute, an educational institution, in an amount not to exceed \$1,158,750 to provide training to behavioral health students at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Centers, for the period January 1, 2021 through August 31, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by the Hospital Enterprise Fund I.

BACKGROUND:

On January 7, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-718-5 with The Wright Institute for the provision of training to behavioral health students at CCRMC and Health Centers. Students will provide consultation to primary care providers, short term interventions, individual and group therapy sessions, and psychopharmacologic consultations, for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.
