The RJOB is comprised of 18 members, including nine representatives from local community-based organizations (CBOs) and nine ex-officio members from specified local justice system agencies. The RJOB meets on a quarterly basis and its members also serve on its three subcommittees that each currently meets on a monthly basis.
