### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of County Novation Contract #74–379–11 with People Who Care Children Association, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$229,795, to provide Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) services for the period from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, which includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$114,898.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This contract will be funded 100% by Mental Health Services Act.

### **BACKGROUND:**

This contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing work experience for 200 multicultural youth residing in the Pittsburg/Bay Point communities, as well as programs aimed at increasing educational success among youth who are either at-risk or high-risk of dropping out of school, or committing a repeat offense. Expected program outcomes include increases in social connectedness.

On September 10, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #74–379-10 with People Who Care Children Association, to provide MHSA PEI services for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2020. Approval of Novation Contract #74–379–11 replaces the automatic extension under the prior contract and allows the contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2021.
