Subject: Contract #26-699-9 with Semon Bader, M.D.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-699-9 with Semon Bader, M.D., an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 to provide orthopedic services for Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Center patients, for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract will be funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I.

BACKGROUND:

On December 10, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-699-8 with Semon Bader, M.D., to provide orthopedic services, including, but not limited to clinical coverage, consultation, training, on-call and administrative services for CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers, for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Approval of Contract #26-699-9 will allow the contractor to continue to provide orthopedic services to CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Center patients through December 31, 2021.
