Subject: Amendment #72-131-1 with Full Court Press Communications Incorporated

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract Amendment Agreement #72-131-1 with Full Court Press Communications Incorporated, a corporation, effective November 1, 2020, to amend Contract #72-131, to increase the payment limit by \$750,000, from \$300,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,050,000 and to extend the termination date from February 28, 2021 to December 31, 2021, for additional consulting, technical support and strategic planning for County's Community Connect Program and COVID-19 response and communications.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Whole Person Care funding.

BACKGROUND:

On July 23, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #72-131 with Full Court Press Communications Incorporated, to provide consulting, technical support and strategic planning for County's Community Connect program for the period August 1, 2019 through February 28, 2021.
