This is a nonfinancial agreement.


BACKGROUND:

This Agreement #28-941 will allow the Contra Costa Public Health Department to conduct COVID-19 related investigations and surveillance in partnership with CDPH and other partnering counties. This includes enhanced laboratory testing for outbreak investigations, contact tracing, determining potential reinfections, assessment of control measures in high-risk settings and high-risk populations, coordinating with connected jurisdictions and healthcare systems to improve understanding of transmission among communities, and to
