RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #24-958-30 with Rubicon Programs Incorporated, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$270,000, to provide mental health services for CalWORKs clients, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this contract will result in budgeted annual expenditures of up to \$270,000 for FY 2021-2022 and will be funded 100% by CalWORKs allocations.

BACKGROUND:

This contract meets the social needs of the County's population by providing specialized substance abuse treatment and prevention programs to help clients to achieve and maintain sobriety and to experience the associated benefits of self-sufficiency, family reunification, cessation of criminal activity and productive engagement in the community. The County has been contracting with Rubicon Programs Incorporated for mental health services since August 1998.
