## **BACKGROUND:**

The Public Works Department is involved in various projects in the County which require street lighting and municipal engineering services. After a solicitation process, Fehr & Peers was selected as the firm to provide these services on an "on-call" basis. On April 18, 2017, the Board approved a three-year contract with Fehr & Peers to provide these services. The Public Works Department is requesting that the Board approve an amendment to extend the original contract date for one year. The extension would allow the completion of tasks already in progress. Fehr & Peers will assist Public Works staff as needed and will be used
