Subject: Contract #77-341 with National Seating & Mobility, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #77-341 with National Seating & Mobility, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,730,000, to provide durable medical equipment to Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members, for the period June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2023.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract will result in contractual service expenditures of up to \$1,730,000 over a two-year period and will be funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II.

BACKGROUND:

CCHP has an obligation to provide certain specialized health care services for its members under the terms of their Individual and Group Health Plan membership contracts with the County. This contractor has been a part of the CCHP Provider Network for several years, formerly under a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with CCHP, and was required to convert to a county contract.
