APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee (the Director of Environmental Health or Assistant Director of Health Services), to submit Grant Application #28-961 (TA-6), to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), Waste Tire Amnesty Grant Program, to pay County in an amount not to exceed \$12,392, for the Environmental Health Solid Waste Program to provide free and convenient waste tire collection events for Contra Costa County residents, for the period from August 1, 2021 through October 31, 2023.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this application will result in an amount not to exceed \$12,392 from CalRecycle from the local government Waste Tire Amnesty Grant Program for the Environmental Health Solid Waste Program. No County match is required.

BACKGROUND:

CalRecycle offers the Local Government Waste Tire Amnesty Grant Program pursuant to Section 42889(e) of the Public Resources Code. The purpose of the grant is to provide free and convenient waste tire collection events for Contra Costa County residents, businesses
