#### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #74-365-13 with Jee Hyun Guss, M.D., an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$329,280, to provide outpatient mental health services for the period from September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Approval of this contract will result in annual expenditures of up to \$329,280 and will be funded as budgeted by the department in FY 2021-22, by 100% Mental Health Realignment funding. (No rate increase)

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Dr. Guss has been providing psychiatric services for mentally ill adults in central Contra Costa County, since September 1, 2009.

On September 8, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-365-12, with Jee Hyun Guss, M.D., in an amount not to exceed \$329,280, to provide outpatient psychiatric services, including diagnosing, counseling, evaluating and providing medical and
