Subject: Contract Amendment #1 for the On-Call Contract(s) for Various Road, Flood Control, and Airport Maintenance Work, Countywide.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute Contract Amendment #1 to contracts with GradeTech Inc., A. Teichert & Son, Inc., Kerex Engineering, Inc., and McGuire and Hester, to extend the contract completion dates from May 12 2021 to May 12, 2022 for each contract, with no change to the payment limit, for the On-Call Contract(s) for Various Road, Flood Control, Airport Maintenance Work, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

These on-call contracts were funded 100% by local road, Flood Control District and Airport Enterprise funds. This action is only to extend the contract and not to increase the payment limit. (No fiscal impact)

BACKGROUND:

On May 12, 2020, the County awarded four (4) on-call contracts for various road, flood control, and airport maintenance work to supplement Public Works Maintenance crews

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

The contracts were awarded in the priority order below, became effective on May 12, 2020, and are set to expire on May 12, 2021.

* GradeTech Inc., in a not-to-exceed amount (\$900,000.00) and unit prices submitted in the bid (\$1,436.00 Total Unit Price);

* A. Teichert & Son, Inc., in a not-to-exceed amount (\$900,000.00) and unit prices submitted in the bid (\$1,585.00 Total Unit Price);

* Kerex Engineering, Inc., in a not-to-exceed amount (\$900,000.00) and unit prices submitted in the bid (\$1,857.75 Total Unit Price);

* McGuire and Hester., in a not-to-exceed amount (\$900,000.00) and unit prices submitted in the bid (\$1,878.00 Total Unit Price).

To retain the services of and enable timely payment to GradeTech Inc., A. Teichert & Son, Inc., Kerex Engineering, Inc., and McGuire and Hester, the Public Works Director recommends that the Board approve Contract Amendment #1 and authorize the Public Works Director, or designee, to sign Contract Amendment #1 for the County. This amendment will extend the completion dates for each contract from May 12, 2021 to May 12, 2022. There are no changes to the maximum payment limits.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Failure to approve the contract amendment may prevent the Public Works Department from completing routine and emergency road, flood control, and airport maintenance work in a timely manner.
