Subject: Contract with Ombudsman Services of Contra Costa, Inc. for Long-Term Ombudsman Services

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Ombudsman Services of Contra Costa, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$505,120 to provide countywide ombudsman services to seniors, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This will increase department expenditures by \$505,120, funded 19% by Federal revenues from the Federal Older Americans Act Title III-B and Title VII-A revenue (CFDA# 93.044, 93.042), and 81% by the State Public Health Licensing and Certification Program, Health Facilities Citation Penalties Account, Skilled Nursing Facilities Quality and Accountability Funds, and State Older Americans Act Title III-B. There is no required County match.

BACKGROUND:

Ombudsman Services of Contra Costa, Inc. responds to reports of abuse of residents of long-term care facilities. Their services also include representing residents with issues related to day-to-day care, health, safety and personal preferences. Funding for this contract comes from the California Department of Aging Area Plan contract with the County via the
