#### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #24–933–43 containing mutual indemnification with Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$8,389,976, to provide subacute skilled nursing care services for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Approval of this contract will result in budgeted expenditures of up to \$8,389,976 and will be funded by 8% Mental Health Services Act (\$671,030) and 92% Mental Health Realignment (\$7,718,946) revenues. (Rate increase)


### **BACKGROUND:**

The Behavioral Health Services Department has been contracting with Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc., since July 1997 to provide sub-acute skilled nursing care for the County's Severely and Persistently Mentally Ill (SPMI) and neurobehavioral clients.

On June 16, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #24-933-42 with Crestwood
