Subject: Contract with Contra Costa County In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority for In-Home Supportive Services

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute an agreement with Contra Costa County In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Public Authority, a public agency, in an amount not to exceed \$2,573,000 to provide in-home caregiving services to IHSS recipients for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This will increase department expenditures by \$2,573,000 to be funded with 16% County, 34% State, 50% Federal.
(CFDA 93.778)

BACKGROUND:

The County Board of Supervisors enacted Ordinance Number 98-14 March 1998 establishing the Contra Costa County In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority (PA) as an independent public agency pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions Code section 12301.6. While the PA is an Independent public agency providing service to the County, it also receives services from County departments. The relationship requires an
