## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Service Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #77-349 with One Access Medical Transportation North Bay, a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000, to provide non-emergency medical transportation services for Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This contract will result in contractual service expenditures of up to \$300,000 over a three-year period and will be funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II revenues.

## **BACKGROUND:**

CCHP has an obligation to provide certain specialized health care services for its members under the terms of their Individual and Group Health Plan membership contracts with the County.

Under new Contract #77-349 the contractor will provide non-emergency medical transportation services to CCHP members for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.
