Subject: Contract #77-378 with Sanhyd, Inc. (dba Kyakameena Care Center)

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #77-378 with Sanhyd, Inc. (dba Kyakameena Care Center), a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$525,000 to provide skilled nursing facility (SNF) services to Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract will result in contractual service expenditures of up to \$525,000 over a 3-year period and will be funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II.

BACKGROUND:

CCHP has an obligation to provide certain specialized health care services for its members under the terms of their Individual and Group Health Plan membership contracts with the County. This contractor has been a part of the CCHP Provider Network for several years, formerly under a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with CCHP and was required to
