BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

Bureau regularly receives Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) discretionary funding to operate self-sufficiency programs under the advisement of the County's Economic Opportunity Council. The self-sufficiency programs have the goal of ameliorating poverty in Contra Costa County through programs that address housing, comprehensive health services, economic development and food security. Examples of programs to receive funding include those that provide employment training, housing payment assistance, wrap-around health services, and food distribution.

This board order is to accept the County's allocation of \$28,250 from June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The Department will be hampered in its ability to operate self-sufficiency programs in the community, and to establish partnerships with community based agencies and public organizations.
