RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a revenue contract with the California Department of Social Services in the amount of \$4,869,906 to provide childcare and development programs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids [CalWORKs] Stage 2) for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This agreement is funded by the California Department of Education and no County match is required. The State funding number is C2AP 1008-00; County number is 29-213-39. This contract is 21.8% (\$1,063,180) funded by Federal dollars passed through the State Department of Education [CFDA #93.575], and 78.2% (\$3,806,726) funded by the State.
