Subject: Interagency Agreement with Contra Costa County Office of Education

---

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Chief Probation Officer, or designee, to execute an Interagency Agreement with the Contra Costa County Office of Education (CCCOE) in an amount not to exceed \$193,931 for the CCCOE to continue to provide assistance to individuals as they transition from the County's adult detention facilities for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

100% Community Corrections Performance Incentive funds (SB 678).

**BACKGROUND:**

Under this agreement, the Contra Costa County Office of Education (CCCOE) provides 1.0 Full time Equivalent (FTE) Reentry Transition Specialist, supported by a .75 FTE office assistant, to assist individuals as they transition from the County's adult detention facilities back into Contra Costa County communities. They support incarcerated individuals by identifying and addressing barriers to employment, education and community reintegration; providing incarcerated individuals individualized case management services. They link students with appropriate support resources, including reentry centers, social services,
