Subject: Prohibit parking at all times on a portion of Shell Avenue (Road No. 3281), Martinez area.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

ADOPT Traffic Resolution No. 2021/4507 to prohibit stopping, standing, or parking at all times on the south side of Shell Avenue (Road No. 3281), beginning at a point 100 feet east of the eastern curbline prolongation of Birch Street (Road No. 3485AJ) and extending easterly a distance of 128 feet, as recommended by the Public Works Director, Martinez area. FISCAL IMPACT:


No fiscal impact.

BACKGROUND:

Contra Costa County Fire Protection District Captain Nicholas Sinosky contacted the Public Works Department's Transportation Engineering Division to request parking prohibitions at a location along the frontage of District Fire Station #12, located at 1240 Shell Avenue in unincorporated Martinez. Traffic Engineering staff responded by conducting a site visit with Captain Sinosky to assess the ingress and egress clear space requirements for the fire truck and equipment. Subsequently, District Captain Sinosky submitted a letter to the Public Works Department formally requesting a "Red Zone" for a segment of Shell Avenue and
