RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE Appropriations and Revenue Adjustment No. 5016 authorizing new revenues in the amount of \$6,369,436 to the Employment and Human Services Department, Community Services Bureau (0588) for the Head Start, Early Head Start and Early Head Start Childcare Partnership Grants awarded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This action is to adjust estimated revenues and appropriated expenditures based on additional funding approved by the Administration for Children and Families (ACF). The funding is 100% Federal. Estimated revenues and appropriated expenditures by each federal grant are as follows:

- 1. \$853,265: To adjust revenues based on the issued Notice of award (NOA) # 09CHO10862-03-03 for approval of carryover of unobligated funds, from program year one to year three in the amount of \$514,825 for Early Head Start and \$338,440 for Head Start; funds allocated to Org #1432 and #1462.
- 2. \$2,635,040: To adjust revenues based on the issued Notice of award (NOA) # 09HP000111-04-02 for \$1,177,478 to extend the grant period from September to
