### BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

On December 6, 2011, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2011/497 adopting policy governing appointments to boards, committees, and commissions that are advisory to the Board of Supervisors. Included in this resolution was a requirement that applications for at large/countywide seats be reviewed by a Board of Supervisors committee. At Large seats on the Alcohol and Other Drugs Advisory Board are assigned to the Family and Human Services Committee (FHS) for review and recommendation to the Board of Supervisors. At the March 28, 2022 Family and Human Services Committee meeting, the Committee considered and recommended the appointment of Michael Ward to Member At-Large Seat 5 on the Alcohol and Other Drugs Advisory Board (AODAB) for a term expiring on June 30, 2023.

### CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Failure to appoint a member is likely to reduce public participation in advising policy development.
