The cost for service is included in the Department of Information Technology's Security budget and will cover all County departments except the Health Services Department. (100% Charges to Users)


BACKGROUND:

On March 2, 2021, the Board approved a software and services agreement with CrowdStrike, Inc. and a purchase order with General Datatech, L.P. for the purchase and implementation of CrowdStrike Falcon Complete software. This anti-virus protection software provides 24x7 monitoring, detection and response activities to detect and prevent account breaches. The software was deployed in 2021 and has been working very
