RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Purchasing Agent, or designee, to execute on behalf of the Public Works Director, a blanket purchase order with Crafco, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$400,000, for Crafco crack seal material, for various types of road maintenance work, for the period April 26, 2022 through April 25, 2025, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of purchasing Crafco crack seal material is funded 100% by Local Road Funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Maintenance Division maintains over 660 miles of County roads. On February 22, 2022, the County issued Invitation for Bid (IFB) 2202-541 for Crafco Crack Sealant, a proprietary product. The Public Works Department uses Crafco Crack Sealant for County road maintenance activities Countywide. There is no requirement to spend the allocated amount during any year.
