Dokken Engineering is qualified to perform those services when needed and requested by the County.

Under a standard services contract with the County, Dokken Engineering will perform project management and right of way services when and to the extent requested by the County. The County will pay Dokken Engineering hourly, at rates that range from \$70.00 to
