Work performed under this as-needed contract is funded with charges to various facilities projects.


BACKGROUND:

On June 26, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved a contract with Quality Assurance Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Consolidated Engineering in the amount of \$850,000 through the period of June 26, 2021.

On December 27, 2018, Amendment No. 1 was made to the contract to increase rates.

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

On January 9, 2020, Amendment No. 3 was made to the contract to increase the rates effective June 26, 2019.

The contract payment limit of \$1,250,000 has nearly been reached. Amendment No. 4 is necessary to provide for the additional costs associated with completion of material testing and inspection services for existing and new projects.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Without Board of Supervisors approval, there is a possible delay in completing current projects requiring materials testing and inspection services. Executing this amendment will facilitate the process of various County Facilities projects requiring materials testing and inspection expertise.
