Subject: Amendment to Agriculture Fee Schedule

RECOMMENDATION(S):

1. OPEN the public hearing on Resolution No. 2022/180 amending the fee schedule for the Agriculture Weights and Measures Department;
2. CONSIDER public testimony concerning the proposed increases;
3. CLOSE the public hearing, and ADOPT Resolution No. 2022/180, amending the fee schedule for the Agriculture Weights and Measures Department effective June 1, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

It is estimated the proposed fee increases will generate approximately \$13,000 in additional annual revenue.

BACKGROUND:

In 2016, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2016-06 approving the Agriculture Weights and Measures Department's current fee schedule. Since 2016, the Department's cost of providing services has increased as well as the cost of some of the materials used in programs. The Agricultural Commissioner has evaluated the current fees and determined an increase in certain fees are necessary in order to cover the costs of the services provided by the Agriculture Department.
