## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the District Attorney, or designee, to submit an application and execute a grant award agreement, and any extensions or amendments thereof pursuant to State guidelines, with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), Victim Services & Public Safety Branch, for funding of the Victim/Witness Assistance Program in the amount of \$1,434,094 for the period October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The District Attorney will receive \$1,434,094 in revenue with a required match of \$324,195. The Department anticipates approval of a match waiver for the required match in its entirety. It would otherwise be met either in-kind or as a cash match. This revenue has already been budgeted.


## **BACKGROUND:**
