This contract meets the social needs of the County's population by providing augmented board and care services including, but not limited to room and board, and twenty-four (24) hour emergency residential care and supervision for mentally ill adults. The Health Services Department has been contracting with God's Grace Caring Home, Inc., since September 1, 1995, to provide augmented board and care services.
