Subject: Contract #27-812-6 with Taraneh Mostaghani, M.D., Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #27-812-6, with Taraneh Mostaghani, M.D., Inc., a professional corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$3,300,000, to provide pediatric primary care services to Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members and county recipients, for the period September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2025.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract will result in contractual service expenditures of up to \$3,300,000 over a 3-year period and will be funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II revenues. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

CCHP has an obligation to provide certain specialized health care services for its members under the terms of their Individual and Group Health Plan membership contracts with the county. This contractor has been a part of the CCHP Provider Network providing pediatric

On July 14, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-812-5 with Taraneh Mostaghassi, M.D., Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for the provision of pediatric primary care services to CCHP members and county recipients, for the period September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2022.

Approval of Contract #27-812-6 will allow the contractor to continue providing pediatric primary care services through August 31, 2025.
