Subject: Consulting Services Agreement with Fehr & Peers, for On-Call Transportation Engineering Services.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a Consulting Services Agreement (contract) with Fehr & Peers, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, for the period September 20, 2022, through September 19, 2025, to provide on-call transportation engineering services, Countywide. (Project Nos. Various) (All Districts)

FISCAL IMPACT:

Work performed under this on-call contract will be funded by developer fees, local road funds for road projects, and various other funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department is involved in various projects in the County that require transportation engineering services for road projects. After a solicitation process, Fehr & Peers was selected as one of five firms to provide transportation engineering services on an "on-call" basis. The consultant will augment Public Works staff on an as-needed basis. They will be used as an extension to Public Works staff during busy times when extra help is needed or when in-house expertise is not available. This on-call contract will be in effect for
