Subject: APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the execution of a Blanket Purchase Order with International Coatings

Company, Inc., for traffic striping material and paint.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Purchasing Agent, or designee, to execute on behalf of the Public Works Director, a blanket purchase order with International Coatings Company, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$750,000, for thermoplastic traffic striping material and rapid dry waterborne paint, used for road maintenance work, for the period November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2025, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

100% Local Road Funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Maintenance Division maintains over 600 miles of County roads. For the reasons of motorist and public safety, and implementing federal and state mandates, the Maintenance Division applies traffic striping for center lines, shoulder lines, stops, limit bars, crosswalks, and all road markings. In addition, rapid dry waterborne paints help protect the watershed, the environment, and the public. The County issued Invitation for Bid (IFB) 2206-573 for thermoplastic traffic striping material and rapid dry waterborne paint.
