## **BACKGROUND:**

The Committee has been charged with developing an area health plan to determine specific health needs of the community, identifying priorities to address those needs, and facilitating a request for proposals process to make funding recommendations for health programs in the community to the Board of Supervisors. The Committee includes representatives from the local community including two seats for Bay Point Municipal Advisory Council (MAC) representatives. Marcia Lessley has resigned from the Bay Point MAC Seat 2.
