## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-784-13 with CardioNet, LLC, a limited liability company, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, to provide remote cardiac monitoring services for patients at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Contra Costa Health Centers, for the period from November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this contract will result in annual expenditures of up to \$250,000 and will be funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I.

# **BACKGROUND:**

Due to the limited number of specialty providers available within the community, CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers relies on contracts to provide necessary specialty health services to its patients. CCRMC has been contracting with CardioNet, LLC, since November 2014, for their expertise in cardiac monitoring services.
