Subject: Police Dispatching Services

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Sheriff-Coroner, or designee, to execute a contract with the City of Pittsburg to pay the County an amount not to exceed \$8,000,000 to provide police dispatching services for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2027.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

No Net County Cost. \$8,000,000 revenue over five years.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Office of the Sheriff will provide police dispatching services, limited to law enforcement activity for the City of Pittsburg. Services will include dispatching, call-taking, sending and receiving voice and data traffic, answering emergency (911) calls and warrant checks to aid the the city's Police Department. This agreement includes a provision for mutual indemnification between the City of Pittsburg and the County.

**CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

Failure to approve this contract will result in the inability of the Sheriff's Office to provide the City of Pittsburg with adequate 911 Dispatcher Services resulting in a safety concern for
