BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department Facilities Services Division is responsible for the maintenance and repair of all County buildings and facilities. The County regularly receives requests for services that vary in size, scope and equipment needed to fulfill these requests. Mark Scott Construction, Inc., provides maintenance, repairs and general construction services.

Government Code Section 25358 authorizes the County to contract for the maintenance and
