RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract Extension Agreement #26-792-8 with Edward Y. Tang, M.D., Inc., a corporation, effective February 15, 2023, to extend the termination date from February 28, 2023 to May 31, 2023 with no change in the original payment limit of \$1,230,000, for orthopedic services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Contra Costa Health Centers.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None, there is no change in the original payment limit of \$1,230,00 which is funded by 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

Due to the limited number of specialty providers available within the community, CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers relies on contracts to provide necessary specialty health services to its patients. CCRMC has contracted with Edward Y. Tang, M.D., Inc., for orthopedic specialty services since March 2015.

On February 4, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-792-7, with Edward Y. Tang, M.D., Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,230,000, for the provision of orthopedic services at CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers, for the period March 1, 2020 through February 28, 2023.

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

Approval of Contract Extension Agreement #26-792-8 will allow the contractor to continue providing orthopedic services through May 31, 2023.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, the necessary specialty orthopedic services needed for patient care will not be available or will create increased wait times due to the limited number of specialty providers available within the community.
